

SCHEDULE 3 - AVIATION CHARGES

The following Aviation Charges and Government Mandated Charges, as varied from time to time, apply for the use of the Facilities and Services and are effective from 1 July 2026 unless otherwise indicated. Users may negotiate alternative arrangements for the use of the Facilities and Services in written binding agreements with CHA, referred to as Aeronautical Services Agreements (ASA). CHA reserves the right to levy charges in addition to those described below for the provision of Facilities and Services provided that reasonable advance notice has been given.

All charges exclude GST unless otherwise indicated and are subject to Clause 13 (Goods and Services Tax) of the Airport Conditions of Use.

1. Passenger Facilitation Charge (PFC)

The PFC applies to all arriving and departing passengers on scheduled RPT and private charter operations using our Airport Terminal and/or RPT Apron, unless other arrangements are agreed in writing:

Passenger Facilitation Charge (PFC)	
Per arriving and departing passenger movement using our Airport Terminal and RPT Apron	\$29.17
Per arriving and departing passenger movement using our RPT Apron only	\$19.45

The PFC is expected to be cost-reflective, when adjusted for inflation, over the long term. It has been determined using forecasts of costs and passenger numbers and may be updated from time to time.

2. General Landing Charges (GLC)

The GLC applies to all aircraft and rotary operations at Coffs Harbour Airport, other than scheduled RPT flights or unless other arrangements are agreed in writing. Private charter operations are subject to the GLC in addition to the applicable PFC unless other arrangements are agreed in writing.

4. Aircraft Parking Charges (APC)

RPT Apron

An APC will apply for the use of the RPT apron per aircraft as follows:

Parking charge per aircraft per day	
Less than 9 hours	\$200.00
Greater than 9 hours	\$350.00

General Aviation

A charge of \$22.00 applies per aircraft per 24 hour period or part thereof up to MTOW 5,700kg

5. Other Charges

Escort Services

Escort Services required outside of ARO operational hours incur a fee of \$371.33 per service. Escort services must be booked in advance by emailing operations@coffsairport.com.au.

CHAPL may from time to time facilitate airside and terminal escort services within operational hours and reserves the right to impose any charges applicable for such escort services.

Call Outs

A charge of \$371.33 applies for call outs for an ARO outside of ARO operational hours.

Airside Supervision

A charge of \$100.00 per hour or part thereof applies to Airside supervision by ARO during operational hours.

Electricity Meter Connection Inspection

Each new electricity meter connection requires an inspection that will incur a charge of \$397.00 per inspection.

Meeting Room Hire

Meeting Room Hire is available for \$220.00 for half day and \$335.00 for full day (including 2 car spaces)

Charter Lounge/Apron Parking Package

Use of the Charter Lounge and one (1) aircraft Parking Bay per 24 Hour period will incur a charge of \$500.00.

Access Control

Each user requiring access to airfield operation facilities (either airside or terminal) will need to obtain an Access Card. Access cards will be issued/replaced at a cost of \$50.00.

Airside Drivers License

Airside Drivers License charges	
Airside Drivers License – New/Renewal – valid for 24 months	\$60.00
Airside Drivers License – Replacement	\$30.00
Airside Vehicle Permit	\$30.00

Airside Environmental Charges (AECS)

The AECS is applicable where users are responsible for airside clean-up and do not complete their own clean-up to CHA's satisfaction. Airside clean-up includes but is not limited to cleaning up fuel and hydraulic spills and other airside equipment and infrastructure damage on the apron, taxiway and runway.

The AECS includes the following charges:

- Clean-up rate of \$187.00 per hour calculated in hourly increments (minimum charge of \$187.00 applies per clean-up required); and
- The cost of equipment and materials used in the clean-up; and
- Waste disposal costs
- Call Out fee of \$371.33 if outside operational hours
- Any other third-party costs incurred as a result of the clean-up effort.
